

BROCHURE FOR ADMISSION TO M. Tech in EMBEDDED SYSTEMS FOR THE YEAR 2010

The M. Tech course in 'EMBEDDED SYSTEMS' is a two-year program. The course focuses on practical design aspects of Embedded Systems. The core and elective papers are practical oriented. One year project work is also part of the course.

Objective of the Course

To mould fresh electronics engineers and to upgrade working engineers into High Caliber Embedded System Designers by enhancing their knowledge and skills in various hardware and software design aspects of Embedded Systems. This course offers a range of topics of immediate relevance to industry and makes the students exactly suitable for industries engaged in Embedded System development. This course is also an excellent preparation for those wishing to engage in application research in this rapidly developing area.

Outcome of the Course

- *Participants get exposure with different families and architectures of Embedded System tools such as Microcontrollers, DSPs, FPGAs, RTOS etc.*
- *Participants shall get the expertise required to design any embedded system hardware and software based on any of the above tools*
- *Participants become highly proficient in Embedded Software particularly in real-time programming*

ELIGIBILITY						
<p>a. The candidates shall be an Indian National</p> <p>b. The candidate should have studied the graduate course in an institution approved by the All India Council for Technical Education.</p> <p>c. The candidate shall have a B.E./B.Tech in Electronics/ Electrical/ Instrumentation subjects awarded by the Calicut University or equivalent there to as approved by the University of Calicut.</p> <p>d. Candidates should have a minimum of 60% aggregate marks in the engineering degree exam. For SC/ST and Physically handicapped candidates, a pass in the Engineering degree course is sufficient.</p> <p>e. The candidate should have a valid GATE Score in Electronics/ Electrical/ Instrumentation subjects. Non GATE candidates can also apply. They shall be considered against the vacancies unfilled by eligible GATE candidates.</p> <p>f. GATE score is not essential for Sponsored candidates.</p> <p>g. Candidates who have appeared for the final examination may also apply provided the results are made available on or before 31.10.2010. Such candidates may be considered for provisional admission. However, these candidates must have successfully passed at least six semesters of B.Tech. (Engg.) or three years of Engineering studies on the date of application and the application must include attested copies of the mark lists. On the date of counseling/admission, the students under Semester system must have passed all including the Seventh Semester Examination also and he/she shall produce the original Mark lists up to the Seventh Semester Examination, while the candidates under Year system must have passed all including the third year of engineering and he/she shall produce the Original Mark Lists up to the Third Year of Engineering.</p> <p>Any candidate admitted provisionally subject to his/her producing provisional certificate or mark list as proof of having passed the qualifying examination shall have to discontinue the course, if he/she does not produce the above mentioned complete mark list and degree certificate on or before 31.10.2010.</p>						

SPONSORED SEATS	
	<p>A sponsored candidate must have at least two years of service at the time of applying. Their employers must sponsor them and relieve them to pursue the programme for the full duration of the course. Gate score is not needed for sponsored candidates.</p> <p>Candidates from Central/State Govt. Institutions, Public Sector Organizations and reputed Private Organizations will be considered in this category. Teachers sponsored from AICTE recognized Engineering Colleges and Polytechnics will also be considered in this category.</p>
SELECTION OF CANDIDATES	
	<p>Selection of candidates who have qualified in GATE will be based on their GATE Score subject to eligibility and availability of seats. The admission to the course shall be based on the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Should have passed the B.Tech/B.E course with a minimum of 60% marks. 2. SC/ST and Physically handicapped Candidates should have minimum pass mark. 3. For General and SC/ST category admission, preference shall be given to candidates who have a valid GATE score. 4. Any seats unfilled by eligible GATE qualified candidates shall be filled with NON GATE candidates, the selection of which shall be based on marks in the qualifying degree examination and a separate interview and or test. 5. Those GATE and NON GATE candidates, who have completed the engineering degree course and passed all subjects upto the seventh semester or third year (as the case may be) and are awaiting the results and expect to qualify on or before 31.10.2010 may be considered for provisional admission. 6. In the case of students with the same GATE score then the selection shall be as follows, <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. First preference shall be with GATE Score in the order as given below: Electronics/ Electrical/Instrumentation subjects. b. In case of a further tie, second preference shall be with the qualifying degree in the order as given below: B.E./B.Tech in Electronics/Electronics & Communication/ Electronics & Telecommunication/ Electrical & Electronics/ Electrical /Instrumentation. c. Incase a tie still exists, then the third preference shall be based on the marks in the qualifying degree. d. Incase of a tie still exists, then the fourth preference shall be based on the marks of the next below course (Plus two or Pre University/ Pre Degree or equivalent). 7. For sponsored candidates, minimum 2 years of experience at the time of applying is required and they should produce the necessary certificates such as the Original sponsorship certificate and Original Experience Certificate at the time of counseling/admission. GATE score is not required for sponsored students. Selection of these candidates is based on marks in the qualifying

	<p>examination and performance in the interview with equal weightage for both.</p> <p>8. The counseling/admission will be on 16-07-2010. Individual call letters will not be sent to the candidates for counseling/admission. All those who are applying for the course have to come prepared for counseling and admission on 16-07-2010 with the original mark lists, certificates and other necessary documents.</p> <p>9. Admission is subject to satisfying the requirements and availability of seats. Attending the counseling does not guarantee admission.</p> <p>10. Candidates offered admission would have to remit the one-year fees or at least one-semester fees on the same day of counseling, failing which the admission is not guaranteed.</p> <p>11. Transfer Certificate issued from the institutions last attended must be produced at the time of admission.</p>

RECOGNITION CERTIFICATE							
	<p>For candidates with qualifying degree from Universities and Deemed universities outside Kerala, Equivalence certificate from the Calicut University is required for admission. Only those candidates who are offered admission need to produce the equivalence certificate. It has to be produced within a day of the admission (on or before 17th of July) failing which the admission is lost. Those candidates desirous of knowing whether their university is recognized may check with the university with the following details.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Degree Name 2. Branch of Degree 3. Name and address of the University 4. Name and address of the College 5. Year of passing <p>The fee for Equivalence certificate is Rs 250/- and for recognition, Rs 50/- which has to be paid by chalan or by DD payable in favour of 'Finance Officer, University of Calicut' payable at SBT, Tenhipalam.</p>						
MIGRATION CERTIFICATE							
	All students admitted for the course from Universities other than Calicut University have to produce the migration certificate after joining the course.						
SCHOLARSHIP							
	All GATE qualified candidates are eligible for teaching assistantship (TA) subject to AICTE and MHRDE guidelines. This facility will not be available to sponsored Candidates, Foreign Nationals and Dependants of NRIs. Disbursement of TA will only be done after the Govt. of India makes funds available. As per MHRD directives fellow holding TA ship shall not accept or hold any appointment paid or otherwise or receive any emoluments, salary, stipend etc from any source during the tenure of the award.						

	<p>The students joining the programme under this category will be considered for Teaching Assistantships of Rs. 8,000/- per month, based on the following norms:</p> <p>(a) Students getting assistantship will be required to assist / work for courses, laboratory, or any other related academic / administrative work to the extent of 8 hours per week.</p> <p>(b) The assistantship will be available for a maximum period of 24 months and students with TA have to complete M.Tech in two years.</p> <p>(c) Assistantship will be paid on the basis of monthly attendance.</p>
DISCONTINUING THE COURSE	
	<p>If any student admitted for M.Tech ES discontinues the studies after the closing of admissions in the same academic year or in subsequent academic years, to join other courses or for other purposes, he/she is liable to pay a liquidated damage of Rs. 50000.00 (Rupees fifty thousand only). Any candidate admitted provisionally and has to discontinue the course since he/she does not produce the complete mark list and degree certificate on or before 31.10.2010 will also have to pay the full fees for the first two semesters to get the certificates back.</p>
RAGGING CASES	
	<p>In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past his/her admission shall be refused or if it is noticed later that he/she has indulged in ragging in the past or is indulging in ragging during the period of the M.Tech course duration, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, his/her admission gets cancelled and the authority would expel the student from the institution. Further he/she has to pay a liquidated damage of Rs. 50,000.00.</p>
HOW TO APPLY?	
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Use only the appropriate Application form for admission to M.Tech programme obtained from DOEACC Calicut Centre or downloaded from DOEACC Website www.doeaccalicut.ac.in. 2. Those who want the application form by post have to enclose a self-addressed stamped cover along with the request. 3. A passport size photograph taken not earlier than 3 months is to be affixed on the Application Form. The photo in the application should be self-attested. Four more copies of the same photograph and one stamp size photograph should be produced at the time of counseling/admission. 4. The following Documents should be enclosed with the application: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Attested copies of the Mark Lists & Degree Certificate of the Qualifying Examination. In the case of candidates who have appeared in the qualifying examination and are awaiting results, a Course Completion Certificate from the Head of the Institution last studied and attested copies of Mark Lists up to the pre-final semester/pre-final year. ii. Attested copy of the GATE Score Card (if applicable).

Attested copy of Community Certificate in the case of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates from a competent authority not below the rank of a Tahsildar. iv. 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COUNSELING

	<p>All candidates have to be present personally for an interview on 16-07-2010 with all the necessary documents (originals and attested copies). The interview shall be from 10.00 am onwards. Those who fail to submit the application form before 5.30 pm of 30-06- 2010 and those who don't bring the necessary documents (originals and attested copies) on 16-07-2010 are not eligible for interview or admission.</p> <p>On the date of counseling/admission (16-07-2010), the students under Semester system must have passed all semester exams including the Seventh Semester Examination and he/she shall produce the original Mark lists of all semesters up to the Seventh Semester Examination, while the candidates under Year system must have passed all yearly exams including the third year of engineering and he/she shall produce the Original Mark Lists of all years up to the Third Year of Engineering, failing which they are not eligible for consideration..</p> <p>The selected candidates have to pay the full fees or one-semester fees for registration on the same day. The original certificates and mark lists starting from SSLC or equivalent upto the present qualifying degree have to be submitted. The classes shall commence on 02-08-2010.</p> <p>All result awaiting students who are taking admission have to pay the full one year academic fees. Their admission gets cancelled if they are unable to produce the complete mark lists and provisional/degree certificate on or before 31.10.2010 and if they fail to meet admission criteria. The fees paid by them except the caution deposit will not be refunded in any case.</p> <p>Transfer Certificate issued from the institutions last attended must be produced at the time of admission.</p>
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TEST/INTERVIEW	
	A test/interview shall be conducted for selection of NON-GATE and Sponsored candidates on 16-07-2010. There shall not be any separate intimation for the test/interview and all those who apply shall have to be present in person for the test/interview on 16-07-2010.
